
Who Participated?

Quick Facts About Circles

- 78 people attended at least one (1) circle session of 105 registered
- 20 volunteer facilitators, each of whom participated in 8 hours of facilitation training
- Average attendance during circles was 6-7 people (plus two facilitators)
- 58 Evaluation Respondents
- 65.5% First Time Circle Participants; 34.5% Returners
- 60.7% attended 4 circles; 26.8% attended 3 circles; & 12.5% attended 2 or fewer
- 77.6% Female; 22.4% Male
- 86.2% of Circle Participants reported English as their primary language
- 32.2% of participants identified as people of color (versus 25.2% in broader Medford population)
- 18% are 14-25 years old; 39% are 26-55 years old; 44% are 56 years or older
- 32.8% lived in Medford for 4 years or less; 32.7% lived in Medford 20+ years



Race/Ethnicity of Medford, MA compared to Circle Participants






Primary Language

86.2% of Circle Participants reported English as their primary language versus an estimated 72.3% of Medford Residents (Census Bureau)

Primary languages of participants included: French (2); French Kreyol (1); Portuguese (2); Chinese (1); Malayalam (1); Russian (1)

Most commonly spoken non-English languages in Medford are Spanish (4.22%); French Creole (4.05%); and Portuguese (3.98%)






Age Range



Likelihood participants would recommend Medford Conversations to a friend





1 – 6: Detractors (1.9%)

9-10: Promoters (61.2%)


Outcome of Circle Experience for Participants


